In this section, you will need to provide background information on Topic 1 and include how the issue at hand relates to your country/role. You can find information on this in the background guide as well as external resources. This should be around 2-3 paragraphs.

Possible Solutions

In this section you should talk about possible solutions to solve the problem of Topic 1. You should have multiple feasible solutions that correlate to your role's stance on the issue at hand. You can present these ideas the day of the conference to assist you in making alliances and doing something significant in committee. Furthermore, it should be around 4-6 paragraphs as this section is the most important.

Topic 2: (Topic Name)

Background Information

In this section, you will need to provide background information on Topic 1 and include how the issue at hand relates to your country/role. You can find information on this in the background guide as well as external resources. This should be around 2-3 paragraphs.

Possible Solutions

In this section you should talk about possible solutions to solve the problem of Topic 2. You should have multiple feasible solutions that correlate to your role's stance on the issue at hand. You can present these ideas the day of the conference to assist you in making alliances and doing something significant in committee. Furthermore, it should be around 4-6 paragraphs as this section is the most important.

Conclusion

This section should include a brief summary of what you previously stated. It should be around 1-2 paragraphs.

Works Cited

In this section you must cite all of your sources, not including the background guide, using MLA 9 formatting guidelines. You are allowed to use citation generators to assist you in this process, including platforms like "Citation Machine" or "MyBib". Please don't use AI in your position paper, as all chairs will be AI checking your papers. The use of AI in a position paper will result in your disqualification, or the inability to win an award, causing your performance in committee sessions to be disregarded.
